

Capstone Requirement

Ways to meet the requirement:

1. Take the class in the event it was/is offered (not likely or guaranteed)
2. Compete in two ASC competitions (not as an alternate.....Although it is up to your faculty coach to determine based on your level of involvement on the team)
3. Compete in one NAHB competition (as a presenting member of the team)
4. Take an alternate class (you may provide justification and request that a class be reviewed by the undergraduate committee to be accepted as a Capstone) or take one of the follow preapproved classes:

- CFM 594R Sustainable Community Development (South)
- CFM 500 Construction Innovation and Technology (Bingham)
- CFM 535 Heavy Civil Construction Practices (Farnsworth)
- CFM 550 (CFM 450 currently) Virtual Design and Construction (can't double count this class if it is already a part of your contract)
- CFM 580 Leadership in the Built Environment (Smith)
