Capstone Requirement

Ways to meet the requirement:

- 1. Take the class in the event it was/is offered (not likely or guaranteed)
- 2. Compete in two ASC competitions (not as an alternate.....Although it is up to your faculty coach to determine based on your level of involvement on the team)
- Compete in one NAHB competition (as a presenting member of the team)
- 4. Take an alternate class (you may provide justification and request that a class be reviewed by the undergraduate committee to be accepted as a Capstone) or take one of the follow preapproved classes:

- CFM 594R Sustainable Community Development (South)
- CFM 500 Construction Innovation and Technology (Bingham)
- CFM 535 Heavy Civil Construction Practices (Farnsworth)
